Sibling Discount

Sibling discounts increment progressively in accordance with the number of siblings attending the College. The discount is applied to the the total College fees as follows:

1st sibling	15% discount
2nd sibling	30% discount
3rd sibling	45% discount
4th + sibling	60% discount

Annual Family Charge

Capital Levy	\$700
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Charged once a year, per family, regardless of the number of children attending the College. The Capital Levy helps fund the ongoing development of the College.

Books & Electronic Resources

The cost of books is determined by year level and according to subject choice. The College has engaged Champion Education to supply the required text books and stationery to Middle and Senior School students. Electronic resources may be supplied by the College as alternatives to booklist selections. There are no book costs for Junior School students.

Enrolment Guarantee Fee

An Enrolment Guarantee Fee of \$700, which is non-refundable, applies to all new students and is payable on acceptance of the Offer of Enrolment.

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College Fee Payment Terms

In order to assist parents, the Council has provided three options for the payment of fees:

Annually

Where the full year's fees are paid by 15 February 2019, the College offers a 3% discount.

Termly

Term fees will be issued quarterly and the due date for payments are:

Term 1	15 February 2019
Term 2	10 May 2019
Term 3	2 August 2019
Term 4	25 October 2019

By Instalment

Fees can be repaid, by agreement, on an instalment basis.

Instalment agreements will be drawn on a weekly, fortnightly, or monthly basis to ensure payment of fees in full by 1 November 2019.

Where fees are not paid in accordance with the agreed contractual arrangements, however, a late payment administration fee of \$100, per term, will be charged to your account.

The College is not in a position to carry debts outside the agreed arrangements and the College Council requires that the College policy on the payment of fees be enforced and any unpaid fees be collected promptly.
