Terms and Conditions

- Lessons are 30 minutes duration and are conducted at school, during school hours at a set time up to Year 7, and, on a rotational basis where possible from Year 8.
- Music Tutors will endeavour to teach the equivalent of 16 lessons a semester (8 per term) which will allow for student sickness and absence due to school activities. More lessons may be taught by arrangement between the tutor and the parent.
- Fees: Individual Lesson - \$31 per lesson. (**Music Students Years 9 – 12 must have individual lessons.**)
- Paired Lesson (2 students) - \$16 per lesson per student. (Paired lessons are not available for voice, piano and keyboard.)
- Group Lessons (3 students by arrangement only) - \$15 per lesson per student.
- Fees are paid to the tutor and not to the school.
- **The parents agree to pay the Instrumental Tutor all fees as agreed within the time prescribed by the Music Tutor. If any fees are not paid within the prescribed time the parents agree to meet any administrative costs imposed by the Instrumental Tutor including (but not limited to) legal fees, location and service fees, and any fees or commissions charged by collection agencies. The Instrumental Tutor reserves the right to terminate all services if fees remain unpaid beyond the agreed date.**
- The tutors **MUST** be notified of a planned student absence (ie: holiday or school excursion) **24 hours prior to the scheduled lesson. If your child is unwell you MUST notify the Tutor before 7.00am. In this instance, parents must telephone the tutor at home (Please do not telephone the College to leave a message as it may not reach the tutor before the scheduled lesson).** Parents will be billed for a lesson if a student is absent without the tutor being notified. Parents will also be billed for a lesson if a student is at the College and fails to attend his/her lesson.
- Written notification to the Director of Music is required before the end of the term if the student wishes to discontinue music lessons and the full terms tuition must be paid. **Failure to notify the Director of Music of cancellation of lessons means that the tutor will assume that the student is absent and parents will continue to be billed accordingly.**

General Information to Parents

- Students must practise regularly at home and are encouraged to perform at recitals.
- Recommended daily practise times for students: Year 9, 30 minutes, Year 10, 30 minutes, Year 11, 45 minutes and Year 12, 1 hour.
- Parents should arrange for the hire of instruments as soon as they are notified that instrumental tuition is confirmed.
- Alternatively, instruments can be hired through Size Music 8373 3370 or Mountford Music 8555 1736.
- Reports will be issued at the end of each semester (Terms 2 and 4).
- **Tuition commences in Week 1 or 2 and you will be contacted by the tutor regarding your first lesson.**
- Timetables are displayed on the Music Centre noticeboard.
